## Waste that cannot be collected or disposed of

- **Disposal of television sets, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers (home appliances for recycling)**  
The City cannot dispose of these items as they are handled through a dedicated recycling route.
  - ▶ **When replacing with a new item** Please consult the retailer from which you plan to buy a new item regarding the disposal.
  - ▶ **When disposing of the item** Please contact the retailer from which you purchased the item or your local appliance store.
  - ▶ **If bringing the item to the collection facility** Pay the home appliance recycling fee at the post office and bring the item to the designated collection facility after confirming business hours and other information in advance.

## Business waste

- The City does not collect waste from stores, offices, factories, etc. For such waste, please contact a Kadoma City collection and transportation licensed contractor. For more information, please visit the Kadoma City website.
- **Disposal of industrial waste, construction waste, hazardous materials, etc.**  
Kadoma City will not collect waste that the City cannot properly dispose of, waste that cannot be disposed of according to the City's disposal rules, or waste that is defined by law as industrial waste. Such waste should be disposed of properly by the disposer himself/herself, the retailer, or a specialized disposal company.
  - ▶ **Industrial waste** Construction waste (blocks, roofing tiles, wood, mortar, soil, tiles, etc.), Hazardous materials (fire extinguishers, batteries, waste oil, paint, chemicals, gas canisters, toxic substances, etc.), Car and motorcycle parts (seats, tires, wheels, bumpers, etc.), Items that are difficult to dispose of (fireproof safes, bowling balls, iron dumbbells, dumbbells, barbells, etc.), Business waste, Wire rope, Motorcycles, Car parts, Car tires, Pallets, Steel drums, etc.

## Small appliance recycling

Electronic devices such as mobile phones, cameras, game consoles, video equipment, audio equipment, etc. (Items that fit into a 15 cm x 30 cm slot)

## Mercury waste

Items that contain mercury, such as fluorescent lamps, dry cell batteries, clinical thermometers, thermometers, blood pressure monitors, etc.

## Bring-in waste (Reservations required, Charged)

## Animal remains

- ▶ **Pet** (There is no dedicated incinerator.)  
[Fee] 500 yen per one set of remains  
Put the remains in a cardboard box, etc., and bring them to the Clean Center with proof of your address. The procedure can be handled at the City Hall night-duty room on Saturdays, Sundays, and after office hours.
- ▶ **Cats and dogs with unknown owners**  
Clean Center staff will come and collect the remains free of charge.
- **About waste sorting and collection**
  - ▶ Please contact us for items that are not on the sorting list or if you are not sure how to sort out your waste.
  - ▶ Collection times may vary depending on the amount of waste and traffic conditions on that day. Any waste put out after collection cannot be collected. Please put out your waste by 9 a.m.

**\*1**  
Items with the longest side or diameter of 30 cm or less should be disposed of on the "small-sized waste" day.

**\*2**  
Tie up to 4 pieces with string in a bundle and dispose of on the "small-sized waste" day, labeling it as "不用品 (disused items)."

**\*3**  
Large quantities of shredded paper cannot be collected. If the volume is small enough to be disposed of in a 45-liter bag as "household waste," it can be collected. (Please sprinkle lightly with water to prevent scattering.)

**\*4**  
Items with the longest side or diameter exceeding 30 cm are classified as "large-sized waste (charged)," including disassembled items.

**\*5**  
Items with the longest side of more than 2 m cannot be collected.

**\*6**  
Excluding battery-operated/rechargeable battery-operated LCD "portable TVs" and "car TVs."

**\*7**  
To prevent fire, soak them in water before disposal.

**\*8**  
Up to 3 bags on the collection day in the latter half of the week

**\*9**  
Cut into pieces no thicker than 5 cm and no longer than 1 m, up to 2 bundles at a time. Roots and stumps cannot be collected.

**\*10**  
Label the item as "不用品 (disused items)" before disposal.

**\*11**  
Solidify the oil or soak newspapers or other papers with the oil before disposal. Liquids cannot be collected.

**\*12**  
Be sure to use up the contents, put the item in a separate bag, and label it as "キケン (dangerous)" before disposal.

**\*13**  
Wrap the item in paper and label it as "キケン (dangerous)" before disposal.
